The federal Student Right To Know Act requires that annually (no later than July 1) institutions of postsecondary education prepare and disseminate information about their graduation rates of full-time, first-time students enrolled in undergraduate programs leading to a certificate, or an associate's or Bachelor's degree. In addition, the institution must provide information on:

- Graduation rates disaggregated by gender, by each major racial and ethnic subgroup as defined by the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), by recipients of a Federal Pell Grant, by recipients of a Federal Direct Loan (other than a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan) who did not receive a Federal Pell Grant, and recipients of neither a Federal Pell Grant nor a Federal Direct Loan (other than a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan),
- Retention rates reported to IPEDS,
- Placement rates reported to accrediting or state agencies and types of employment obtained by graduates, and
- Types of graduate and professional education in which graduates of the institution's four-year degree programs have enrolled.

EMPLOYMENT RATES (NOT REQUIRED TO BE REPORTED TO ACCREDITING OR STATE AGENCY)

The calculation of rates includes students who graduated from a program from November 1, 2022, to October 31, 2023, were available for employment, and were employed before November 1, 2024 (“Graduates Employed”). The Graduates Employed figure includes all employment, including employment that began before enrollment, during the program, or after graduation. The Graduates Employed figure includes any reported employment, including in job titles included in the list of job titles published by the institution for which the program prepares students (in the field), jobs that require use of skills learned in the student’s program as a predominant component of the job (related field), and other employment (out of field). The calculation of these rates does not include students who graduated from a program and were unavailable for employment due to death, permanent disability, continuing education, active military service, visa restrictions (international students), or incarceration (“Graduates Unavailable for Employment”).
